### **Who is eligible?**

- An individual 45 years old and older that has made a significant contribution to our community
- Not currently running for office or serving as an elected official
- Not a current board member of the LWV-Pueblo

As you write your nomination, consider the following:

- **Our Mission:** Empowering Voters. Defending Democracy.
- **Our Vision:** We envision a democracy where every person has the desire, the right, the knowledge and the confidence to participate.
- **Our Value Statement:** The League believes in the power of women to create a more perfect democracy.

### **The following criteria will be considered:**

- What level of community (local, state, national) involvement has the nominee had, and what level of influence has occurred? (This can have occurred in a quiet or public manner.) Give examples.
- How has their career, work, volunteerism served the public?
- How have the efforts of the nominee supported and encouraged equality and empowerment of others/ community?
- Is the nominee involved on community boards, commissions and a member of community organizations?
- Are there examples of leadership, advocacy and innovation in the efforts of the nominee?
